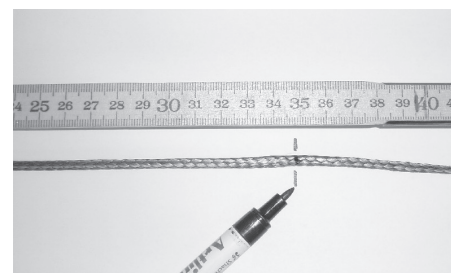


HMPE bridle with knot

Introduction: This instruction describes how to make a bridle with HMPE on a spinn. pole using bowline knot with locking.

Bowline with lock

1. Cut the HMPE rope with a hotknif into length according to specification.
(or $L = 300 + 1,1 \times XL$)
2. Mark both HMPE rope ends at 350 mm from end, see pic 1.
3. Fit the HMPE rope through the pole end fitting, see pic 2-3.
4. Make the bowline knot at 350 mm and lock the end of rope, see pic 4-7.
5. Cut the rope end after the bowline knot and leave a maximum of 15 mm HMPE rope, see pic 7.

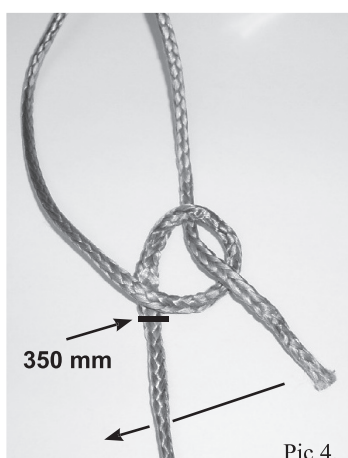

Bowline knot



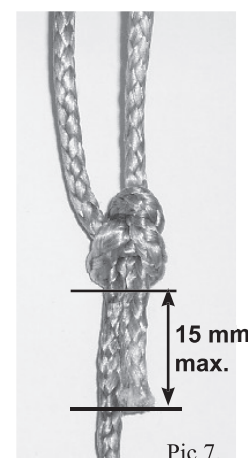

6. Fit the ring at the middle of HMPE rope with a clove hitch, see pic 8-12.

7. Fit the second rope end into the remaining pole end fitting with a bowline (with lock).
8. Adjust the ring to the centre of bridle and spinn. pole, see pic 13.
